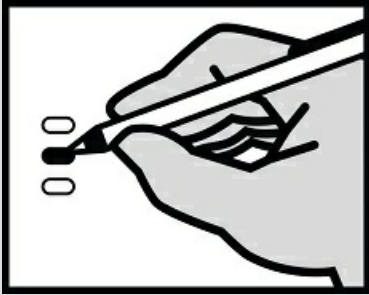

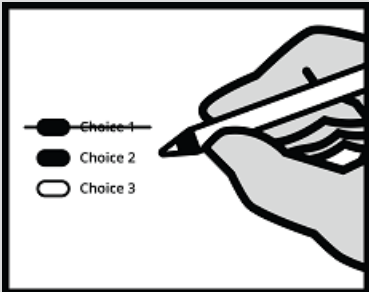

**CAPITAL LEVY FOR HEALTH, SAFETY, SECURITY AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS**

The Board of Directors of Wahluke School District No. 73 adopted Resolution No. 12-2020, concerning a proposition to improve school facilities. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, on all taxable property within the District, to make health, safety, security and infrastructure improvements throughout school facilities (including replacing roofs, upgrading HVAC, modernizing fire alarm and security systems, providing additional classrooms, and modernizing CTE Vocational Education Center):

**REPLACEMENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND  
OPERATION LEVY**

The Board of Directors of Ephrata School District No. 165/55J adopted Resolution No. 2020-2021-6, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's educational programs and operation expenses not funded by the State of Washington:
