The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Bob Bainsky at 11:05 a.m. followed by introductions.

Minutes were reviewed and a motion was made by Bob to accept the minutes as written, the motion was seconded by Jon.

**Hazardous Material Spills:**

No new reports.

**Old Business:**

Reverse 911, Jon reported that there were some calculation errors and \$5,000.00 more was needed to complete the information download side of the system. Brett requested more information on the system and the shortfall to see if Conoco Phillips could assist.

Wheeler Corridor Siren, there was no representative from Grant County Fire District 5 to update the situation. Last month it was reported that the module to activate the siren via telephone controls needed to be installed. Sam mentioned that the location of the siren is on property that has been sold to a new owner and that we needed to investigate the agreement of the previous owner with the new owner.

### **New Business:**

Meeting location and time, the Armory space is reserved through the month of June, July and August the room is not available. From August through the end of the year we would need to request the room as new staff at the Armory will occur.

The Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP), Emergency Support Function (ESF) 8, Public Health and Medical Services, appendix for Mass Casualties which includes the Coroners plan and Emergency Medical Services plan are currently being reviewed by Emergency Management, Health District, and Coroner.

The building team looked at getting Industry, Law, Fire, and citizens to work together and how to get them involved with LEPC and projects such as Reverse 911. A brochure is being developed to assist with the 'why should I participate' and to include why the current members participate. *(Please submit comments, suggestions, and reasons why your agency participates to [sduffey@co.grant.wa.us](mailto:sduffey@co.grant.wa.us) )* It was also discussed that **WE** are all a part of **GRANT COUNTY LEPC** and not 'Moses Lake LEPC and Ephrata LEPC' etc therefore it was decided that we are Grant County LEPC, Moses Lake Chapter, Ephrata Chapter, etc giving each group their own 'Chapter' identity but working together as one LEPC.

The training team is working on an ICS workshop to be followed by a tabletop exercise to familiarize industry to ICS terminology of first responders and how it can fit into their plans. The date for the workshop has not been set.

The planning team is working on a full scale exercise for 2009. General scenario consists of a fire and or vapor cloud at REC Silicon.

The Ephrata Chapter will be conducting a Table top Exercise on May 8<sup>th</sup>. This will be a Radiation exercise.

The Grant County PUD had a presentation from their March 12<sup>th</sup> functional exercise. One of the lessons learned from this exercise was that the phones were always busy and perhaps a dedicated out-going line would assist in this situation. Also communication is extremely important and understanding of messages was confusing at times. Overall the exercise was excellent.

### **Roundtable:**

**Grant County Emergency Management**, training opportunity, Risk Management Program (RMP) in June, cost of training is free (see *attached flier*). April is Earthquake safety month, on the 22<sup>nd</sup> is the earthquake drill if your agency would like to participate (see *attached flier*). May 1 will be the exercise for the Gorge Amphitheater, this year's exercise scenario will be a riot.

**Grant County Health District**, is working on agreements for Points of Dispensing of the Strategic Stockpile and Region 7 Health Exercise on Radiation.
