I. Introductions

III. Hazardous Materials Spills

November 3, 2009 a fire occurred in a drain collection sump in a waste treatment area and was the result of a chemical reaction between fine particles of silicon, sodium hydroxide (caustic) and water. This chemical reaction produces gas which bubbled through the water in the sump, where the gas ignited and burned. There were no injuries associated with the fire. The plants Emergency Response Team quickly contained the fire and extinguished it. TNS was activated and the neighbors were notified of the event, updated, and advised of the termination of the event.

IV. Old Business

Community Plan, Randy is collecting the information from the Critical Infrastructure Key Resource planning to incorporate into the Community Plan.


