III. Hazardous Materials Spills

February 1st, the Bureau of Reclamation, Grand Coulee Dam had a turbine oil spill of 10 gallons into the water. The coaster gate behind the dam leaked oil through a bad fitting during the recycling process. The dam was shut down where the sheen was and booms and absorbents were deployed. The release was secured.

V. New Business

Health District Update, H1N1 vaccinations for the schools is complete, over 7,000 vaccinations have been administered. Between 60-70 volunteers were utilized for the vaccination clinics.
