June 22nd Washington State Emergency Management Division called to advise that on June 18th that Granite Northwest Inc reported for the responsible party of a 50 gallon oil spill with 5 gallons in the water occurred near Blue Lake. The caller stated there was a spill of materials from a tack oil distributor truck due to the tank being overfilled. The caller also stated that oil booms were placed in the water to contain the spill, absorbent pads were placed in the water to remove the spill. A backhoe was used to remove the impacted soil.
