

# Call for Projects

## QUADCO—Lincoln, Grant, Adams and Kittitas Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan

Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) has released the Public Transportation Grant Application for July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2013. You may access the grant forms and information at [www.wsdot.wa.gov/transit](http://www.wsdot.wa.gov/transit).

The federal legislation, SAFETEA-LU, requires the establishment of a locally developed, coordinated public transit-human services transportation plan for all human services transportation programs. WSDOT requires that all applicants for the Consolidated Grant Program participate in the planning process with their local Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO). All projects must come from the needs and strategies identified in the plan. The *QUADCO—Lincoln, Grant, Adams and Kittitas Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan* may be accessed at [www.pfp.org](http://www.pfp.org).

In addition to the planning requirement, all projects must be submitted for prioritization and ranking. *(Please review Appendix C of the WSDOT Public Transportation Grant Application).*

- **Coordination:** Assure non-duplication and coordination of resources
- **Unmet/Greatest Need:** Meets the identified needs of the population.
- **Effectiveness/Cost Efficient:** Transportation resources are available, accessible and adaptable to meet the needs. Transportation resources provide community savings.
