The Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, Washington, reserves the right to reject any and all bids. The award of this proposal, if made, may be made in whole or in part as determined to be in the best interest of Grant County.

The improvement for which bids will be received follows:

Fuel Purchases for 2008

This proposal provides for furnishing and delivering approximately 201,300 gallons of unleaded regular gasoline, 202,500 gallons of clear and red dye diesel #2, and 11,300 gallons of red dye heating oil per year at seven locations in Grant County and other work in accordance with the specifications.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1) Sealed bids plainly marked "**Bid for Fuel Purchases for 2008**" will be received by Grant County at the Office of the Board of County Commissioners, P.O. Box 37, Grant County Courthouse, Ephrata, Washington 98823, until **1:45 P.M., Tuesday, February 12, 2008** and will then and there be opened and publicly read for supplying the specified materials.
- 2) Bidders may bid on any combination of items or portions of items.
- 3) Bids shall be submitted on the forms provided by Grant County. Other sheets or forms will not be accepted.
- 4) Bidders shall complete the entire proposal form. If no bid is represented for a particular item then the Bidder shall write "**NO BID**" in the space provided for "Total Price".
- 5) Bidders shall make no changes or amendments to the proposal. The contract provided is informational only and will be awarded to the successful Bidder(s).
- 6) The proposal must be signed by the proper official of the Company submitting the bid.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

This proposal provides for furnishing and delivering approximately 201,300 gallons of unleaded regular gasoline, 202,500 gallons of clear and red dye diesel #2, and 11,300 gallons of red dye heating oil per year at seven locations in Grant County and other work in accordance with the specifications.

DATE OF OPENING BIDS

Sealed bids plainly marked "**Bid for Fuel Purchases for 2008**" will be received at the following location before the specified time:

The bid opening date for this project shall be **February 12, 2008**. The bids will be publicly opened and read after **1:45 P.M.** on this date.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

The County will award this contract in whole or in part as is determined to be in the best interest of the County.

The weekly publication, Oil Price Information Service (OPIS), PAD 5, reports the average rack price by terminal and brand. OPIS is published weekly by United Communications Group, 11300 Rockville Pike, Suite 1100, Rockville MD 20852, (908) 901-8800, or circulation office (301) 816-8950, Ext. 223. The date of the OPIS PAD 5 report expected to be used for comparison of bids is stated on the proposal form. Information from the latest OPIS publication may be made available to the prospective bidder upon request.

The Company must list the terminal location for each product on the proposal.

The Company has the option of listing either the **brand** for each product or using the **average weekly price** for each product. The Company must declare its intent to use a brand or use the weekly OPIS PAD 5 average on the proposal. The OPIS PAD 5 5-day average will not be used.

SCOPE OF WORK

The objective of this Contract is to provide the following fuels for Grant County operations:

1. Unleaded Regular Gasoline with an octane rating of 87.
2. Red Dye and Clear Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel No. 2.
3. Red Dye High Sulfur Heating Fuel
4. Winterized diesel blended at 50% No 1 and 50% No. 2

The Company agrees to furnish and deliver fuel products within twenty-four (24) hours from the time the County makes an oral or written request specifying the location and type of fuel, excluding the period from 5:00 P.M. Friday to 7:00 A.M. Monday. The Company further agrees to schedule fuel deliveries to the County in order to minimize the occurrence of empty fuel storage tanks.

All deliveries of fuel products by the Company shall be made during normal County working hours. Delivery receipts must be signed for by the County. The Company shall dip the tanks or read meters prior to fuel delivery and after and record this information on the delivery slip along with the date and time of the delivery. Copies of the delivery slips shall be faxed to 509-754-6087 (Public Works) no later than the day following the delivery. Failure of the Company to obtain the written signature of a representative employed by the Department of Public Works acknowledging receipt of delivery of fuels may result in the forfeiture of all or part of any payments due the Company for the fuel delivery made.

SCHEDULE OF LOCATIONS, FUEL TYPES, AND TANK SIZES

The following schedule represents a two (2) year average of fuel usage throughout Grant County. It is offered to provide the Company with an estimate of demand. The quantities listed are for the convenience of the bidder only.

Actual quantities may be larger or smaller than the amounts listed. The Company shall make such revisions in the work as necessary to accommodate changes in the demand without additional compensation.

PAYMENT

The OPIS PAD 5 average rack price shall be used to increase or decrease the contract prices. The Contractor shall add his bid margin to the published average rack price shown on the proposal for the terminal or brand selected and invoice the County accordingly. The County shall verify all invoices for conformance with OPIS PAD 5 on all weekly price adjustments.

The Company shall be paid by the County for completed work and services rendered under this Contract as provided in the bid proposal. Such payment shall be full compensation for work and services performed for all labor, materials, supplies, equipment, applicable taxes, and incidental costs necessary to complete the work.

All invoices shall be submitted by the Company to the County for payment pursuant to the terms of this Contract. The County will pay the appropriate amount of each voucher to the Company.

All invoices shall document the time, date, place, type of fuel delivered, quantity, and be signed by an appropriate representative of the Dept. of Public Works.

The prices shown above shall be adjusted in accordance with the applicable Oil Price Information Service/PAD 5 reports. The Company shall increase or decrease the price of the delivered fuel based upon the change in OPIS/PAD 5 for the confirmed moves of the OPIS/PAD 5 report through the week prior to the delivery for the terminal port and brand indicated on the proposal.

The company shall list and add all applicable taxes to the delivered fuel price after the OPIS/PAD 5 adjustment.

INDEMNITY

The Company hereby agrees to indemnify and the County harmless from and shall process and defend at its own expense, all claims, demands, or suits at law or equity, arising in whole or in part from the Company's negligence or breach of any of its obligations under this Contract. The Company shall secure liability and property damage insurance coverage in amounts not less than:

The Company agrees to provide Grant County a certificate of insurance naming Grant County as an additionally insured party against all acts of the Company for the life of this contract.

CONTRACT TERM AND RENEWAL

The term of this Contract shall be one (1) year beginning March 1, 2008. The Company and County may extend this Contract at any time for a period of up to two additional one (1) year periods.

MATERIALS

All materials supplied under this proposal shall conform to industry standards and all federal and state regulations for shipping, handling and quality. Introduction of biodiesel and biodiesel blends shall be allowed when sufficient quantities are available and become listed on the OPIS publication.

TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

The County reserves the right to terminate this contract at any time upon giving not less than thirty (30) days written notice to the Company.

In the event of the death of the member of the Company signatory to this Contract, the surviving members of the Company hereby agree to complete the work under the terms of this Contract, if requested to do so by the County. This section shall not be a bar to renegotiations of this Contract between surviving members of the Company and the County, if the County so chooses.

In the event this Contract is terminated under any of its terms the final payment shall be made within 45 days from the date of termination.
