



Sealed bids, plainly marked “**Bid for Two-Way Radios and Programming Services, Equipment Contract 2012-01**”, will be received by Grant County at the Office of the Board of County Commissioners located in the County Courthouse, 35 C Street NW - Room 207, P.O. Box 37, Ephrata, WA 98823, until **1:30 PM, Tuesday, January 24, 2012**, and will then and there be opened and publicly read for furnishing and delivering:

Informational copies of the proposal and specifications are on file with the County Engineer in the Grant County Public Works Building, 124 Enterprise St. S.E., Ephrata, WA 98823.

Any bidder offering new equipment must include in their proposal an offer to purchase the trade-in equipment. Grant County assumes the new equipment bidder’s trade-in offer is a part of the bid including the new equipment. The bidder’s trade-in offer will only be considered separately if the bidder completes Part II of the Proposal and provides a 5% bid security or checks the box to permit consideration of a trade-in offer separately.

Any person or company may make an offer to purchase the trade-in equipment independent of a bid on the sale of the new equipment. Such offers shall be made on forms provided by the County in Part II of the Proposal. The bidders are advised that the radio equipment will continue to be used until replacement radios and programming services are delivered. The County is offering the following trade-ins:

Trade-Ins:

All equipment is offered “AS IS”. Prospective buyers may view the equipment at the convenience of the operator. Please call the department to make arrangements to inspect the equipment. All radio equipment is operating and currently in-service.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject or accept any or all portions of the bids received.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1) Sealed bids, plainly marked "**Bid for Two-Way Radios and Programming Services, Equipment Contract 2012-01**", will be received by Grant County at the Office of the Board of County Commissioners located in the County Courthouse, P.O. Box 37, 35 C Street NW - Room 207, Ephrata, WA, 98823, until **1:30 PM, January 24, 2012**, and will then and there be opened and publicly read for the delivery of goods and services
- 2) The Bidder may submit a bid on any or all items listed. If the Bidder does not wish to bid any particular item or items, please write "**NO BID**" on the appropriate proposal sheet.
- 3) Multiple bids for the same item may be made by the Bidder. Please copy the appropriate proposal sheet(s) for the item(s) to be bid with more than one model. The proposal for each item bid must be completed. Please number the proposal sheets accordingly.
- 4) The proposal must be completed and the proposal signature sheet must be signed.
- 5) An informational copy of the contract is provided to the Bidder. Please read it but do not sign it.
- 6) All exceptions or changes to the specifications must be shown on the proposal sheet(s) in the space provided or attached to the proposal sheet.
- 7) The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject or accept all or part of the proposal submitted by the Bidder.
- 8) Bidders are advised that the unit price bid for each new item will be compared with other public agency contract prices for similar equipment. After said comparison the County may reject or accept all or part of the proposal submitted by the Bidder and purchase items directly from the State or other public agency contracts.
- 9) Trade-ins are offered for sale in this contract. Bidders offering new equipment are required to make an offer on the trade-in equipment listed. Interested parties that are not offering new equipment may submit a bid for one or more of the trade-in equipment listed. A 5% bid security is required for offers made on all trade-ins from bidders completing Part II of this proposal. Although no minimum bids are reserved the County will compare trade-in offers to reliable publications or other sources.

Interested parties bidding for trade-in equipment are required to post a 5% deposit based on the bid amount offered for the equipment. The deposit will be held until the purchaser provides the whole amount for all equipment awarded to the high bidder. If the purchaser fails to pay for the awarded equipment within the allotted time, the deposit shall be forfeited to the County.

PROPOSAL - PART I

General Conditions

The attached specifications are for the purpose of providing details regarding the type of product desired by Grant County. Equal or similar products from reputable manufacturers and suppliers are permitted. Grant County shall be the final determiner of product equivalence.

Bidders interested in providing bids for new equipment must complete and return Part I of this proposal.

The successful Bidder has 15 days from the date of award to sign and return the contracts. Failure to sign and return the contracts may result in the loss of the contract to the Bidder. No performance bond is required for this bid proposal.

Grant County shall pay State sales and use taxes on all products and services purchased. The Bidder shall not include taxes in the bid price and shall show state sales taxes as a separate item in the space provided.

Grant County is a political subdivision of the State of Washington and is exempt from paying all Federal excise taxes. The Bidder shall furnish Federal excise tax exemption certification when applicable. All other taxes and costs of business shall be borne by the Bidder and included in the base price offered.

The bidders are advised that radio equipment will continue to be used until replacement radios and programming services are delivered.

All products shall conform to applicable Federal and State safety and health laws, rules and regulations.

Miscellaneous Information

Grant County Public Works operates three repeaters under FCC Licenses. One repeater, TKR-7400S, will be re-used in this re-programming proposal. One repeater, TKR-720, will be replaced in this re-programming proposal. One repeater, Motorola MSR2000, will be disconnected and left in place.

- Repeater Call Sign WPUR 782 located on Beezley Hill. Frequencies will be provided to the successful bidder. Repeater is Kenwood TKR7400S broadcasting at 100 watts. This repeater is narrow band capable and will be reprogrammed.
- All mobile and portable radios shall program this frequency pair as Channel ONE
- Repeater Call Sign WPUR 782 located on Mattawa Shop. Frequencies will be provided to the successful bidder. Repeater is Kenwood TKR 720 broadcasting at 50 watts. This repeater is not narrow band capable and will be replaced.
- All mobile and portable radios shall have car to car with PL tone using WPUR 782 programmed as Channel TWO
- Repeater Call Sign KKK 505 located on Beezley Hill. Frequencies will be provided to the successful bidder. Repeater is Motorola MSR2000 broadcasting at 100 watts. This repeater is not narrow band capable and will be disconnected and left in place.
- Several auto and shop mobile radios will be programmed using the GCSO car to car frequency on Channel FIVE as authorized by the Sheriff.

Bid Evaluations

Bid evaluations shall include, but not be limited by, the following criteria:

- Price (*may include life cycle*)

- Quality of product
- Conformance to specifications
- Prompt service and parts availability
- Training
- Bidder's previous contract experience
- Public's best interest.

Submissions to be included with the Bid Proposal

Bidders are advised to submit the following with each bid item:

- Descriptive literature.
- Complete operating dimensions and sketches of the proposed unit.

The Bidder may submit any other information that may assist Grant County in evaluating the bid.

Full Service Facility

A full service facility is defined as the location with spare parts available to Grant County within 24 hours from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday thru Friday.

Warranty

The Bidder must state the warranty period(s) on all items bid or portions of each item. Grant County may require a minimum warranty period. Within the warranty period the successful Bidder shall replace all parts and perform all repairs which are required or made necessary due to defective design, materials, workmanship, or non-conformance with the specifications. Unless otherwise noted, the Bidder shall perform all warranty repairs at the Bidder's place of business. Grant County shall deliver and retrieve defective equipment at the Bidder's place of business. All repairs shall have the warranty reinstated for the remaining period.

Operator's, Parts and Service Manuals

The Bidder shall furnish operator's manuals, service manuals and parts manuals as specified in the proposal. **Manuals must be delivered to Grant County before product delivery is considered complete.**

Delivery, Inspection and Acceptance

All equipment shall be new and the manufacturer's latest model. All standard equipment shall be furnished with the unit. The unit and attached equipment, if any, shall be serviced, comply with all specifications, and be in full working order for the purpose it was designed at the time of delivery. **Grant County will accept delivery between the hours of 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM, Monday thru Thursday only.** Unless otherwise noted, deliveries shall be F.O.B., Freight and Insurance Prepaid and Included, to Grant County. The Bidder will be required to obtain a delivery address within Grant County, Washington, and the time from the County Engineer, or his designated representative, for each piece of equipment. The Bidder, or his representative, is requested to be present at the time of delivery.

Supplier(s) shall provide the following documents for review at time of delivery for each item.

- Completed Invoice detailing the items being delivered.

Training

- The Bidder and manufacturer's representatives must be able to provide sufficient training to Grant County personnel to operate, service and repair the equipment. The training will occur in Grant County. Training shall include all labor, equipment, materials, tools, travel and other

expenses needed to provide a complete service. The Bidder may show a minimum number of training hours for each category. Failure to offer any training will be a consideration in the bid evaluation process.

- The Bidder shall state the number of hours and the cost per hour for each category of training on the proposal form in the space provided.
- Training is an additive cost to the contract. The Bidder shall not include training costs in the base bid of the proposal. Grant County is not obligated to use the training offered by the Bidder, however, should Grant County desire to utilize the training programs offered those costs will be added to the contract..

Late Delivery

No penalty for late delivery will be assessed against the Bidder. However, the Bidder is advised that the failure to deliver the equipment before the promised date will be a consideration used at succeeding bid proposal evaluations.

Trade-ins

Grant County is not obligated to accept any trade-in offer and may accept new equipment bid without the required trade-in offer. The trade-in offer itself will be considered to be a part of the whole item and will not be considered separately unless the bidder checks the appropriate line. Bidders wishing to bid for trade-ins only to be considered separately should complete and sign Part II of this proposal and provide a 5% security deposit. No security deposit is required for bidders bidding new equipment and offering trade-in values in Part I of this proposal.

a. Provide radio reprogramming services at eight Grant County shop locations incl travel.

The successful bidder will travel to each of the eight locations shown on the Reprogramming List which follows and reprogram each radio shown to transmit and receive on the narrow band standard on the frequency pair licensed under WPUR 782 w/PL tone on Channel ONE, and car to car w/PL tone one Channel TWO. A frequency and deviation check shall also be preformed on each radio. Radios found out of specification shall be repaired under d. of this proposal item This work shall be accomplished before the repeaters are reprogrammed.

In addition to the programming and frequency check above, the radios listed immediately below shall be additionally reprogrammed with GCSO car to car frequency w/PL tone on Channel FIVE:

b. Provide radio reprogramming services for equipment at remote locations within Grant County incl. travel

The successful bidder is advised that Grant County anticipates some equipment will not be found at the locations shown of the reprogramming list. When that situation occurs the bidder may be asked to travel to the location where the equipment can be found and provide the required reprogramming services. The bidder shall keep an accurate record of such work and invoice the county.

The unit Contract price per hour shall include all costs associated with reprogramming the radios in county equipment located at remote sites and shall include all labor, materials, equipment, tools, travel and all other expenses.

c. Provide radio programming services at the provider’s business location.

The unit Contract price per each shall include all costs associated with reprogramming the radios in county equipment brought to the bidder’s business location and shall include all labor, materials, equipment, tools, travel and all other expenses.

d. Correct discovered frequency and deviation error at the provider’s business location.

The successful bidder is advised that Grant County anticipates some equipment will be discovered with frequency deviation outside the radio’s specifications and will require adjustment and correction at the bidder’s business location. When that situation occurs the bidder shall provide a list of radios and notify the County to bring the radio(s) to the bidder’s business location.

The unit Contract price per each shall include all costs associated with repairing and correcting the frequency deviation in radio(s) brought to the bidder’s business location and shall include all labor, materials, equipment, tools, travel and all other expenses.
