PROPOSAL
(For New Equipment Dealers)

General Conditions

1. The attached specifications are for the purpose of providing details regarding the type of product desired by Grant County. Equal or similar products from reputable manufacturers and suppliers are permitted. Grant County shall be the final determiner of product equivalence.
2. Bidders interested in providing bids for new equipment must complete and return Part I of this proposal.
3. The Bidder has 15 days from the date of award to sign and return the contracts. Failure to sign and return the contracts may result in the loss of the contract to the Bidder. No performance bond is required for this bid proposal.
4. Grant County shall pay State sales and use taxes on all products purchased. The Bidder shall not include taxes in the bid price and shall show state sales taxes as a separate item in the space provided.
5. Grant County is a political subdivision of the State of Washington and is exempt from paying all Federal excise taxes. The Bidder shall furnish Federal excise tax exemption certification when applicable. All other taxes and costs of business shall be borne by the Bidder and included in the base price offered.
6. All products shall conform to applicable Federal and State safety and health laws, rules and regulations.

Bid Evaluations

1. Bid evaluations shall include, but not be limited by, the following criteria:
 - Price (*may include life cycle*)
 - Quality of product
 - Conformance to specifications
 - Prompt service and parts availability
 - Training
 - Bidder's previous contract experience
 - Public's best interest.

Submissions to be included with the Bid Proposal

1. Bidders are advised to submit the following with each bid item:
 - Descriptive literature.
 - Complete operating dimensions and sketches of the proposed unit.

- Complete information detailing engines, engine accessories, transmissions, frame, axles, electrical components, cab, differentials, drivelines, hydraulic systems, and appurtenances for each unit bid.
2. The Bidder may submit any other information that may assist Grant County in evaluating the bid.

Full Service Facility

A full service facility is defined as the location with spare parts available to Grant County within 24 hours from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday thru Friday.

Warranty

The Bidder must state the warranty period(s) on all items bid or portions of each item. Grant County may require a minimum warranty period. Within the warranty period the successful Bidder shall replace all parts and perform all repairs which are required or made necessary due to defective design, materials, workmanship, or non-conformance with the specifications. Unless otherwise noted, the Bidder shall perform all warranty repairs at the Bidder's place of business. Grant County shall deliver and retrieve defective equipment at the Bidder's place of business. All repairs shall have the warranty reinstated for the remaining period.

Operator's, Parts and Service Manuals

The Bidder shall furnish operator's manuals, service manuals and parts manuals as specified in the proposal. **Manuals must be delivered to Grant County before product delivery is considered complete.**

Delivery, Inspection and Acceptance

All equipment shall be new and the manufacturer's latest model. All standard equipment shall be furnished with the unit. The unit and mounted equipment, if any, shall be serviced, comply with all specifications, and be in full working order for the purpose it was designed at the time of delivery.

Grant County will accept delivery between the hours of 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM, Monday thru Thursday only. Unless otherwise noted, deliveries shall be F.O.B., Freight and Insurance Prepaid and Included, to Grant County. The Bidder will be required to obtain a delivery address within Grant County, Washington, and the time from the County Engineer, or his designated representative, for each piece of equipment. The Bidder, or his representative, is requested to be present at the time of delivery.

Supplier(s) shall provide the following documents for review at time of delivery for each item.

2. The manufacturer's line production sheet stating the equipment serial and identification numbers and listing all of the equipment's components. (Maroni sticker)
3. Completed Invoice.
4. The Manufacturer's Statement of Origin (MSO).
5. Axle weight slips (for all units with axles).
6. A completed Washington State title application showing both the legal and registered owner as: Grant County Public Works, 124 Enterprise St. SE, Ephrata, WA 98823. The mailing address is

Training

1. The Bidder and manufacturer's representatives must be able to provide sufficient training to Grant County personnel to operate, service and repair the equipment. The training should occur in Grant County. Training shall include all labor, equipment, materials, tools, travel and other expenses needed to provide a complete service. The Bidder may show a minimum number of training hours for each category. Failure to offer any training will be a consideration in the bid evaluation process.
2. The Bidder shall state the number of hours and the cost per hour for each category of training on the proposal form in the space provided.
3. Training is an additive cost to the contract. The Bidder shall not include training costs in the base bid of the proposal. Grant County is not obligated to use the training offered by the Bidder, however, should Grant County desire to utilize the training programs offered those costs will be added to the contract.

Late Delivery

No penalty for late delivery will be assessed against the Bidder. However, the Bidder is advised that the failure to deliver the equipment after the promised date will be a consideration used at succeeding bid proposal evaluations.







WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the payments, covenants, and agreements, hereinafter mentioned, and attached and made a part of this agreement, to be made and performed by the parties hereto, and the parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

1. The Contractor shall do all work and furnish all tools, materials, labor and equipment necessary to improve and complete **Miscellaneous Equipment Bid 2 - 2016**, located in Grant County, Washington, as proposed in a bid opened **1:30 P.M. March 8, 2016** in accordance with and as described in the herein attached plans and standard specifications, and in full compliance with the terms, conditions, and stipulations herein set forth and attached, now referred to any by such reference incorporated herein and made part hereof as fully for all purposes as if here set forth at length, and shall perform any alterations in or additions to the work covered by this contract and every part thereof and any force account work may be ordered as provided in this contract and every part thereof.
2. The Contractor shall provide and be at the expense of all materials, labor, carriage, tools, implements and conveniences and things of every description that may be requisite for the transfer of materials and for constructing and completing the work provided for in this contract and every part thereof.
3. The County hereby promises and agrees with the Contractor to employ, and does employ the Contractor to provide the materials and to do and cause to be done the above described work and to complete and finish the same according to the attached plans and specifications and the terms and conditions herein contained, and hereby contracts to pay for the same according to the attached specifications and the schedule of unit or itemized prices hereto attached, at the time and in the manner and upon the conditions provided for in this contract and every part thereof. The County further agrees to employ the Contractor to perform any alterations in or additions to the work covered by this contract and every part thereof and any force account work that may be ordered and pay for same under the terms of this contract and the attached plans and specifications.

4. The Contractor for himself, and for his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, and successors and assigns, does hereby agree to the full performance of all the covenants herein contained upon the part of the Contractor.

5. It is further provided that no liability shall attach to the County by reason of entering into this contract, except as expressly provided herein.
