PART 1 - GENERAL

SUMMARY

- A. Aluminum, heavy-duty commercial sliding service window units as described.
- B. One (1) each replacement window unit to fit approximate rough opening of 64" wide x 48" height with 4" frame, to include 30" x 30" manual service window & transom lite, configured OX.
- C. One (1) each replacement window unit to fit approximate rough opening of 64" wide x 48" height with 4" frame, to include 30" x 30" manual service window & transom lite, configured XO.

SUBMITTALS

- A. Product Data: Submit Manufacture's technical product data substantiating that products comply.
- B. Shop drawings: Submit for fabrication and installation of windows. Include details, elevations and installation requirement of finish hardware and cleaning.
- C. Certification: Provide printed data in sufficient detail to indicate compliance with the quote documents.

DELIVERY, STORAGE, AND HANDLING

- A. Deliver windows crated to provide protection during transit and job storage.
- B. Inspect windows upon delivery for damage. Unless minor defects can be made to meet the Owners specifications and satisfaction, damaged parts shall be removed and replaced.
- C. Store windows at building site under cover in dry location.

PROJECT CONDITIONS

- A. Field measurements: Check openings by accurate field measurement before fabrication. Show recorded measurements on shop drawings. Custom metal work may be required at service opening-countertop interface. Show notes on shop drawings. Coordinate fabrication schedule to avoid delay of work.
- B. It is recommended that a site visit is performed before bidding this project. Contact Janice Goeden, Solid Waste Supervisor, (509) 754-6082 to arrange site visit.

WARRANTY

All material and workmanship shall be warranted against defects for a period of one (1) year from original date of purchase.

PART 2 – PRODUCTS

ACCEPTABLE MANUFACTURER'S

- A. Basis of design: Design is based on aluminum (DW) series, deluxe sliding service window manufactured by **C.R. Laurence Co., Inc. (800) 421-6144**. Other products meeting General and Product Specifications deemed equivalent by Owner are acceptable.

MATERIALS

- A. Frames: 4" Aluminum frame modules shall be constructed of 6063-T5 extruded aluminum. Replacement and servicing of glass shall be from the clerk side of the window by means of an access panel in the top header and does not require the removal of the frame from the opening. Window glides on top-hung heavy-duty ball bearing slides. Poly-pile weather stripping and self-latching handle. Overall frame sizes are to be in accordance with industry standards, no filler strips will be allowed.
- B. Finish: All aluminum to be satin anodized.
- C. Glazing: The glazing is to be insulating, 5/8".
- D. Options: Full bottom track

PART 3 – EXECUTION

INSTALLATION

- A. Install window in accordance with the manufacturer's printed instructions and recommendations. Repair damaged units as directed (if approved by the manufacturer and the Owner) or replace with new units.
- B. Installation of one (1) window unit shall be completed before work may commence on second window unit.
- C. Installation must be scheduled between 7:30 A.M. to 3:00 P.M., Monday thru Friday, Thursday is preferred.
- D. Existing window units become property of contractor upon removal.
- E. Existing window units may be disposed of at the Grant County Landfill for no charge.
- F. Traffic Control will be provided by Grant County.
- D. Contact Janice Goeden, Solid Waste Supervisor, (509) 754-6082 at least one week prior to coordinate installation.

CLEANING

- A. Clean frame and glazing surfaces after installation, complying with requirements contained in the manufacturer's instructions. Remove excess glazing sealant compounds, dirt or other substances.

PROTECTION

- A. Institute protective measures required throughout the remainder of the construction period to ensure that all windows do not incur any damage or deterioration, other than normal weathering, at the time of acceptance.
