A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 30, 2019 at 2:00 pm at the project site, located at 4718 Road 'P' NW, Quincy, WA. This meeting is mandatory for General Contractors intending to bid, to obtain critical information about the project and bidding process.

Bidders, both prime and all subcontractors, must be in compliance with the verification requirements and responsibility criteria identified under RCW 39.06.020, and have completed the required Prevailing Wage and Public Works Training through the Washington State Dept. of Labor & Industries, or be on their Public Works Training Exemption List.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed forms and accompanied by a cashier's check, certified check or bid bond executed on the prescribed form, made out to Grant County in an amount

not less than five (5%) percent of the amount of bid.

The Grant County Board of Commissioners reserves the right to reject or accept any or all bids, to waive minor irregularities in any Bids or in the bidding procedure, and to accept any Bid presented which meets or exceeds these specifications and which the Board of Commissioners deems to be in the best interest of Grant County. No bidder may withdraw their bid after the hour set for the opening unless the award of the contract is delayed for a period exceeding 45 days.
