* **Used Oil:** There is a 5 gallon maximum limit allowed at all collection sites. These locations are for used oil that is not contaminated with another substance. Keep antifreeze, brake fluid, water, and gasoline out of your oil. Use a durable container to store used motor oil and store out of the weather. Keep it closed except when pouring oil in. **If oil contains another substance, please call Grant County Solid Waste at 754-6082 ext 3508 to find out where it can be disposed of.**

****Antifreeze:** There is a 5 gallon maximum limit allowed at collection sites.

*****Latex Paint:** Residents may dispose small quantities of latex paint at the Ephrata Landfill and the CDSI Transfer Station. If latex paint is dried and lid removed, residents may dispose of latex paint in their garbage cans.

******E-Cycle Washington Collection sites:** Offer free recycling of laptops, portable DVD players, computer towers, monitors, and televisions to households, small businesses, small governments, special purpose districts and school districts.
