- **Corrugated cardboard only** (*no paperboard such as cereal boxes, pop boxes, etc.*)
- Glass bottles and jars (*All colors*)

**This site no longer accepts plastic bottles for recycling.**

*Remove all items from plastic bags before placing in recycling containers.*

## Reduce Your Waste!

Recycling is great, but reducing waste in the first place is even better. Waste reduction saves disposal costs, protects our resources and saves landfill space at the landfill near Ephrata. Most of all, you can decrease how much you dispose of even with limited recycling opportunities in Grant County. The following are ideas on how to reduce your waste and make a difference:

- Use reusable water bottles.
- Choose items with the least amount of packaging or buy items in bulk quantities if you know you will use all of the product.
- Remove yourself from junk mail lists. Mail or fax the address label back to the company that sent the mail and ask to be removed from the mailing list. Don't fall for "free drawing" forms at stores or restaurants. They usually just want your address to send junk mail.
- Leave grass clipping on the lawn instead of bagging them.
- Donate unwanted items to Goodwill or a local thrift shop. Have a yard sale or give to a friend or relative.
- Cut back on the number of subscriptions to newspapers and magazines. Instead, share subscriptions among family or friends.

#### Commingled Recyclables:

- **Plastic Bottles & Containers:** Plastics #1 PET & #2 HDPE (*Bottles with opening smaller than base only*)  
No lids!
- **Aluminum & Tin Containers** (*Rinsed, metal containers*)
- **Mixed Paper:** Newspaper and inserts, copier & printer paper, magazines, catalogs & phone books
- **Flattened Cardboard and/or Paperboard:** Corrugated cardboard, shoe boxes, cereal, and cracker boxes (*No frozen food boxes*)

**Does not accept:** Plastic bags and film, glass, glass bottles & containers, frozen food boxes, shredded paper, paper food & beverage cartons, scrap metal, batteries, tub containers, lids and caps, plastic clam shell containers, foil, chip bags, aerosol cans, and foam cups & containers

### Accepts in separate containers:

- Corrugated cardboard
- Glass bottles and jars—all colors
- Will buy back separated aluminum cans

**Rinse out all cans and bottles!**

**No plastic bags!**

**No Plastic lids and caps!**
