

## Mercury Containing Lights



Why recycle Fluorescent, CFL, & HID lights? **Washington State law makes it illegal to throw away mercury containing lights in the garbage.**

Where can I drop off my lights?

Lowes and Home Depot accept small numbers of CFLs at their customer service desks at no charge. The lights must be bagged before placing in the receptacle.

Light Recycle Washington Sites accept a maximum of 10 lights per day per person at no charge. Visit [LightRecycle.org](https://www.lightrecycle.org) for more information.
