8/12/2015. City of Quincy annexed parcels, which affected District 3's boundary.

10/3/2014. City of Moses Lake annexed some land and District 5's boundary was adjusted to remove the annexed area.

7/31/2014. City of Quincy annexed some land and District 7's boundary was adjusted to include the interchange area of SR 17 at City of Soap Lake.

6/6/2014. Fire District 15 annexed a small area in T19R27E S01 from Fire District 5.

8/28/2013. Researched and removed pertinent incorporated cities from fire district boundaries.

2/13/2013. Boundaries compared to parcel tax codes and adjusted to match in many instances. There is an absence of input from fire districts as to the validity of their boundaries, so the GIS Department relies on the taxation codes.
