INITIAL & CRISIS SERVICES

During regular business hours, Initial Services provides intake assessments and referrals. Crisis Services provides services to individuals experiencing emergency and/or crisis situations. These services include:

- Crisis Intervention and Assessments
- Crisis Respite
- Outreach and Crisis Stabilization
- Emergency Services



MEDICATION MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Grant Mental Healthcare has two Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioners on staff who can review and prescribe psychiatric medications and provide medication consultations. Grant Mental Healthcare also has a child psychiatrist available from Seattle Children's Hospital. These visits are available through our telehealth system so travel to Seattle is unnecessary!

WELLNESS GROUPS

Grant Mental Healthcare's groups are designed to meet the needs of each individual. Symptom management is offered within all groups to educate persons learning to manage their symptoms of mental illness.



CHILDREN & FAMILY SERVICES

Children and Family services offer Community Support Services, Parenting and Child and Family Therapy.

ADULT SERVICES

Adult Services provide a full continuum of treatment for individuals with mental health needs. Emphasis is placed on providing individualized care to support independent living within the community. Support Services are offered for all adults and individuals with disabilities. Services include:

- Individual Therapy
- Geriatric Behavioral Health Consultation
- Community Support - Grant Mental Healthcare's community based services are provided to assist individuals to lead healthier and more independent lives.

- Prevention and Recovery Center (PARC)
- City View Residential Assisted Living Facility
- Directions in Community Living (DCL) - A residential support program for citizens with developmental disabilities.



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
