## **GRANT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS LOOKING FOR INTERESTED CITIZEN TO SERVE AS AN ALTERNATE ON THE COUNTY WATER CONSERVANCY BOARD**

**EPHRATA** – The Grant County Board of Commissioners announced today they are looking for an interested citizen of Grant County to serve as an alternate member on the Grant County Water Conservancy Board. A water conservancy board has authority to consider and adopt records of decision for state water right transfer applications. The board is a public body and a separate unit of local government in the state. They may adopt fees for processing applications and accept grants to fund the activities of the board. See **Chapter 90.80 RCW** for full WCB authorities. Appointed board members are volunteers, however a board member is entitled to reimbursement from the board for necessary travel expenses and costs incidental to receiving training.

Qualifications:

1. Applicants must reside in Grant County or a county adjacent to Grant County.
2. Appointee must attend 32 hours of training conducted by the Department of Ecology.
