

Prison Rape Elimination Act

PREA

The Grant County Sheriff's Office has zero-tolerance toward all forms of sexual abuse and sexual harassment of prisoners, and will take immediate action to protect those prisoners who are reasonably believed to be subject to a substantial risk of imminent sexual abuse.

All allegations of sexual abuse or sexual harassment will be thoroughly and objectively investigated.

Although inmates have multiple methods and avenues to report incidents of sexual abuse or harassment at their disposal, the following contact information is provided to allow for third party reports of such incidents. These reports may be made in person or in writing, by telephone, and may be done so anonymously by contacting Sheriff's Office personnel:
