



The Grant County Work Release Facility Now offering Electronic Home Monitoring (EHM)

This program was developed to allow offenders the opportunity to maintain their current employment, without being incarcerated, and still abide by the Court's orders.

Once you have been approved by the Sentencing Courts to apply for the EHM Program, a Participant Package must be completed, by the offender, and returned to the Work Release Facility to review and determine eligibility.

Electronic Home Monitoring (EHM) Fees:

The fees for EHM are \$12.00 per day. When you begin the program, you will be required to pay the first 2 weeks in advance (\$168.00), and must be paid at the time the electronic bracelet is placed on your leg.

After the initial \$168.00 payment, all remaining payments must be made one week in advance at all times. Failure to do so would be considered a violation, and could result in your removal from the program.

Cash or Money Order is the only form of payment that will be accepted.
