#### **V. New Business:**

The Health District is involved with 'WATRAC', a Volunteer Health Care Registry for those in the health care profession. Region 7 Health Care will have their functional exercise on May 21, the scenario will be based on an Earthquake event. Grant County's Emergency Operations Center and Ham Radio operators will be participating in this exercise. Public Health is working on 'Standardizing Health Care Credentials' and 'Excessive Heat' advisories.
