April 30, REC Silicon had an accident of an employee removing a pressure gauge while doing so the employee was burned from the hot oil in the lines. This accident is under investigation. The spilled oil was contained and cleaned up.

Public Meetings, Ephrata's meeting was held on April 23, lack of attendance from the public was discouraging however involvement with the vice principal was excellent for future planning.
