July 2, Washington Potato, ammonia leak, employees evacuated safely, team deployed to locate leak and repair, all employees were able to return to the facility. Fire District 4 responded to this call and during their after action reporting noted that their evacuation location is accessible by crossing the highway which is not a safe practice but due to the where the facility is located there are not many choices for an evacuation point.

II. Old Business

TNS/Red Loop Phone, REC and Emergency Management conducted a test of TNS, REC Neighbors. Seven of the 50 REC Neighbors phone numbers did not call out, problem has been identified and should be corrected during the next test. One neighboring industry from the Red Loop Phone has contacted Emergency Management after the initial test to be included for notifications. As of September 1st, REC will no longer support the Red Loop Phone and will rely on the use of TNS. Steve has visited all Red Loop Phone industrial sites and
