The oil was release into the water while conducting turbine maintenance. The spill was contained and cleanup was in process by the time of the notification.

May 7th, Washington State Emergency Management Division called to advise that Cascade Distributing Co spilled a 2,000 pound bag of fertilizer at Highway 28 W and County Road 11 NW, Quincy the bag had broken open in transit. When the tractor/trailer unit was opened the fertilizer spilled onto the ground. The spill was contained and cleanup efforts were in process by the time of notification.
