Another fire under investigation is the Ballenger fire, the Hazardous Substances Emergency Events Surveillance (HSEES) representative was requesting information from GCFD3.

The next outreach opportunity will be during the Farmers Consumer Awareness Fair in August, Troy offered to assist during this Fair along with GCFD3.
