The Quincy Valley Chapter of the Grant County LEPC held their monthly meeting at the Grant County Fire District #3 facility located on C Street SW in Quincy at 9:30am on September 29, 2010.

I. Introductions

The meeting was called to order by Tony and introductions were made.

II. Approval of Minutes

Minutes were reviewed and the motion was made by Bill to accept the minutes as written the motion was seconded by Deb, motion passed.

III. Hazardous Materials Spills

August 26~reporting party stated that Faragano Wrecking Yard in Quincy is not properly draining the fluids out of the car resulting in all fluids being dumped onto the ground.

September 7~Conagra Foods reported a release of an unknown amount of anhydrous ammonia from a low pressure site of the refrigeration system, cause is under investigation

September 23~State Dept of Ecology notification that Columbia Pacific Aviation Inc, reported a spill of Jet A fuel on the tarmac at the Grant County Airport. The spill was reported as less than 13 gallons. Cause of the spill was due to a malfunction of the spill prevention valve on the aircraft. No water sources or drains were involved, material was cleaned up.

September 28~Deb with Columbia Colstor in Quincy reported a spill of approximately 43 lbs of anhydrous ammonia. A leak began in the system causing a valve to shutdown which prevents more anhydrous ammonia from leaking. This facility is leased by Columbia Colstor.

September 29~A traffic accident on L.6 NW and Adams Rd in Quincy caused a fuel spill of approximately 30 gallons of diesel. There was no

threat to the water or environment.

V. New Business
