Fire District 4 responded to this call and during their after action reporting noted that their evacuation location is accessible by crossing the highway which is not a safe practice but due to the where the facility is located there are not many choices for an evacuation point.

July 16, REC, silane release which caused a scrubber stack fire. The fire lasted 15 minutes, Moses Lake fire was dispatched.

July 22, at the Grand Coulee Dam, four gallons of floor stripper was released into the water at the dam, workers dumped a bucket into the wrong location.
