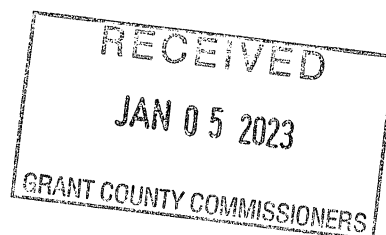

The above grant is a single award grant in the total amount of \$248,500, and GCSO Emergency Management is requesting a budget extension to expend the remaining amount this calendar year. This is a follow-on Budget Extension as the grant was not fully expended in 2022 as originally intended due to supply chain and training scheduling issues.

I am requesting authorization to purchase Hazardous Materials Response equipment under the above grant in the amount of \$72,703. This is the remaining amount of equipment to be purchased out of the previous equipment total of \$219,681.

I'm also requesting authorization to purchase Hazardous Materials Response training under the above grant in the amount of \$27,300.

I'm also requesting authorization to purchase repairs for existing equipment authorized under the above grant in the amount of \$1,519.



The equipment, training, and maintenance that will be purchased with the above grant will be used to support the North Central Washington Hazardous Materials Response Team, which is a cooperative effort between Moses Lake Fire Dept, Wenatchee Valley Fire (formerly Chelan County Fire District 1 and Douglas County Fire District 2) and Chelan County Fire District 7 to provide hazardous materials technician level response capacity for the three county region.

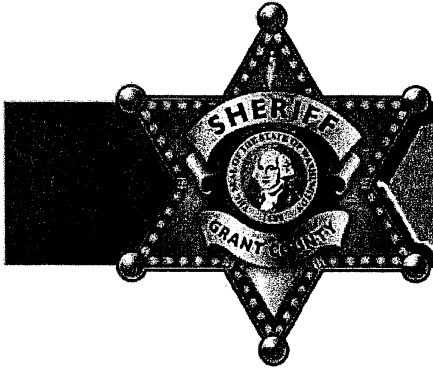
These funds will come out of the grant described above. Grant County Sheriff's Office Emergency Management is the manager of this grant.


