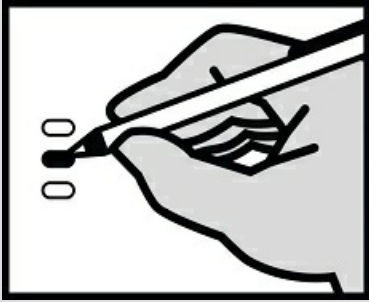

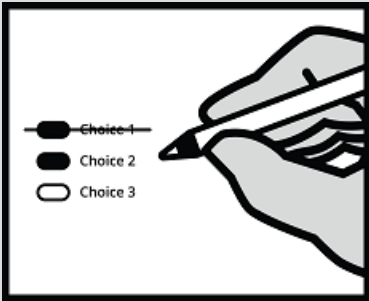

**Proposition No. 1**

**LEVY FOR OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE**

The Commission of Public Hospital District No. 2, Grant County, Washington adopted Resolution No. 21-03, concerning a proposition to finance operations and maintenance. If approved, this proposition would authorize the District to levy a special one-year property tax levy in excess of its regular levy for collection in 2022 in the amount of \$825,000, resulting in an estimated levy rate of \$0.1573 per \$1,000 of assessed value, to provide additional funds to operate and maintain the District's health care facilities and essential services, all as provided in Resolution No. 21-03. #### PROPOSITION NO. 1

#### REPLACEMENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS LEVY

The Board of Directors of Moses Lake School District No. 161 adopted Resolution No. 2021-05, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operations expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's educational programs and operations expenses not funded by the State of Washington:
