- No containers larger than 5 gallons
- Waste must be in trunk of car or pickup bed
- Containers will not be returned to customer

### THESE ITEMS ARE ACCEPTED

Oil based paint, oil stains, latex paint, adhesives, rechargeable batteries, lithium-ion batteries, aerosols, paint thinners, household cleaners, corrosives, pesticides, herbicides, photo chemicals, pool/spa chemicals, old gasoline, road flares, elemental mercury, fire extinguishers, *all mercury-containing lights (Fluorescent bulbs/tubes, CFLs, HIDs—maximum of 10 lights per person—Do not tape lights together)*, mercury thermometers and thermostats, antifreeze, brake fluid, and used oil

*Containers will not be returned.*

### DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS:

Auto batteries, alkaline batteries, cylinders, propane tanks, medication, water-based paint products without the original printed manufacturer's label, sharps, incandescent bulbs, LED lights, ammunition, explosives, empty containers, agricultural waste or commercial waste

*(List is not complete. Items may be rejected based on cost of disposal or transportation issues)*
