This letter constitutes notice pursuant to RCW 29A.08.840 that a voter registration challenge has been filed against you pursuant to RCW 29A.08. This notice informs you of the exceptions allowed to voter addresses under RCW 29A.08.112 (allowances for voters without traditional residence), RCW 29A.04.151 (allowances for absences from your residence for certain purposes) and Article VI § 4 of the Washington State Constitution (allowances for absences from your residence for certain purposes).


