

# Covid-19 Disposal Options

## Ephrata Landfill

To help ensure social distancing and comply with the Governor's Stay Home, Stay Healthy order, **Grant County's Landfill** will be temporarily closing to the public until further notice, effective Friday, April 3, 2020. The landfill will continue to be open to commercial haulers Monday through Friday only.

Contact the landfill for special handling situations such as deceased animals, rotting or about to rot waste, health/safety related items. (509) 754-4319

## Coulee City Drop Box and Mattawa Drop Box

Drop box sites are closed until further notice.

## CDSI Transfer Station

The CDSI Transfer Station, located on Rd. 7 N.E. will be closed on Saturdays and Sundays, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY. CDSI Transfer will be open Monday through Friday, from 7 AM to 3 PM until further notice.

Waste being delivered to the CDSI Transfer Station will be restricted to ESSENTIAL WASTE from self-haulers (i.e., general public). No limitations will be put on commercial haulers at this time. Essential Waste includes but is not limited to:

- Rotting or about to rot waste; and
- Health/Safety related items.

Please refrain from bringing yard or "spring cleaning" waste and consider holding materials to be disposed of at a later time.

To maintain social distancing, and to protect our staff as well as the public, non-essential customers may be turned away until the stay-at-home order has been lifted. You may experience increased wait times. PLEASE BE PATIENT!

Consolidated Disposal Service (CDSI), can provide on-site container services, if needed. Please call (509) 754-2468 or (800) 422-3008 for more information.

## Delano Regional Transfer Station

The transfer station is open to the public from 10:00 am- 12:00 pm on Saturday only. For curbside garbage service within one of the incorporated cities or towns, contact the town directly.
